Graduate Awards Top Up Practices

Award Amount

Top-up*

\$0.00 to \$2,000

There will be no top-up but the student gets to keep the award(s), up to a combined maximum of \$2,000. The amount of the award will not be deducted from the base funding.

Between \$2,001 to \$15,000 (cumulative awards)

Award goes towards the base funding and the student receives a \$2,000 top-up over their base funding.

Over \$15,000 (cumulative awards)

Award goes towards the base funding and student receives a \$4,000 top-up over their base funding.

- All awards that require student applications are eligible for a top-up from their supervisor or graduate unit excluding.
- The total cumulative top-up maximum is \$4,000
